

STAMBAUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD

Regular Meeting

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on February 9, 2022, at 7:00 pm at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Clerk Christensen, Treasurer Rogers, and Trustees Pangrazzi and Stolberg present. Also present was Water Supervisor, Gary Pangrazzi.

The minutes were read from the January 12, 2022, meeting and accepted as read.

Clerk Christensen read the bills for the month and a motion was made by Treasurer Rogers to approve the bills with a second by Trustee Stolberg. Bills were approved.

Treasurer Rogers read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

Mrs. Cole inquired whether the GIS Mapping on our website being paid for in part by Coleman Engineering. Supervisor Isaacson stated that we are independent of Coleman Engineering and plan to continue with our current arrangement which is a reasonable expense and efficiently handled.

Mary Wurzer asked about the results of the meeting regarding the second cell tower by Golden Lake. Supervisor Isaacson said that the meeting had been cancelled.

Kleiman Drilling is waiting for a permit from the state to complete the pump test before they can move forward.

Supervisor Pangrazzi said that he has been dealing with waterline breaks throughout the township. There have been six waterline breaks in the past two weeks.

Our Assessor, Mari Negro, will be working with the Board of Review on March 14th and 15th at the hall. She has also added her information under the GIS Mapping tab on our website.

Property taxes are due on February 28, 2022, thereafter, interest is automatically charged.

The West Iron County Fire Department Christmas party will take place on February 19th.

Trustee Pangrazzi made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second by Treasurer Rogers. Adjournment took place 7:35 p.m.

Our next meeting will take place on Wednesday, March 9, 2022. Our annual meeting is scheduled for March 30, 2022.
