

STAMBAUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD

Regular Meeting

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on August 9, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Trustees Pangrazzi and Stolberg in attendance, Clerk Christensen and Treasurer Rogers were absent. Also present was Water Supervisor, Wyatt Johnson.

The minutes were read from the July 12, 2023, meeting and accepted as read.

Supervisor Isaacson read the bills for the month and Trustee Stolberg made a motion to approve the bills with a second by Trustee Pangrazzi. Bills were approved.

Supervisor Isaacson read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

The new generator has been placed at Indian Lake on the cement slab awaiting Ahlberg Electric to complete the electrical work. The #1 well has been reprogrammed to run more efficiently and the broken or malfunctioning water meters are being replaced as needed.

The Windsor Center is applying for a grant for the Windsor Center Improvement Project for possibly \$1 million. They are seeking local support without any financial commitment from the Township. A motion was made by Trustee Stolberg to support the resolution for their grant application with a second by Trustee Pangrazzi. Motion carried.

Brad Toivonen cleared some trees by University Road to help with the improvement project.

The barking dog situation seems to have been resolved with the game warden. The dogs do wear bark collars and the neighbors do not seem to have any complaints at this time.

Supervisor Johnson reported that the new signs have been placed at Holmes Park and campground money was collected.

Caspian-Gaastra Fire Department won first place in the 2023 tournament with WIC Fire Department taking 4th place. The 2024 tournament will be in Iron River.

The cemetery is doing well. If there is money available at the end of this season, some of the dead trees will be removed.

Supervisor Isaacson read the zoning permits.

Our next regular meeting will be on September 13, 2023.

Trustee Stolberg made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Trustee Pangrazzi.

Meeting adjourned at 7:36 p.m.
