

# STAMBAUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD

## Regular Meeting Minutes

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on January 14, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Clerk Christensen, Treasurer Rogers, and Trustee Stolberg in attendance. Absent was Trustee Pangrazzi. Water Supervisor, Wyatt Johnson, was also present.

The minutes were read by Clerk Christensen from the December 10, 2025, meeting and accepted as read.

Clerk Christensen read the bills for the month. Trustee Stolberg made a motion to approve the bills with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Motion carried.

Treasurer Rogers read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

Zach Hautala with ICECA reported that ad sales for the 2026 Iron County Visitors' Guide have been completed. The Guide is considered to be the best advertising and promotional tool for Iron County. The recipients for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the Fast Track Program were Boujie Bevs, Total Respiratory and Old Town Paws. ICECA is currently working with North Country Website Design on a member communications survey that will help to improve the relationship with members and show areas where improvements could be made.

Jon Ahlberg, our Windsor Center representative, reported that the Windsor Center was very busy. He also reviewed questions the public had been asking regarding the Center and some of its operations. Resident, Jim Chartrand, reported that the new carpet for the bocce courts had arrived, but it was the wrong carpet and will have to be replaced. Robert Cole mentioned that none of the three treadmills were working in the exercise room.

Supervisor Isaacson and Craig Richardson with Wickwire presented a proposal for improvements at Holmes Park. Trustee Stolberg made a motion to accept the proposal with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Motion carried.

Supervisor Johnson reported that a few waterline leaks had been repaired by Hiawatha and Stromberg Roads. There have been less waterline breaks this winter than same time last year which is likely a result of the increased snowfall this year over the past few years. The new truck should be ready soon, awaiting the box to be put in place.

Discussion took place regarding a prospective agreement to share an excavator and trailer with Iron River and Bates Townships. A draft agreement was reviewed sent from Mike Stafford and a meeting will be scheduled with all participating parties to iron out the details of the agreement.

The Zoning Administrator and a Board of Review position are open and we are seeking candidates for these positions. Interest was expressed by two people for the Deputy Treasurer's position, but neither person fit the situation that we needed to be fill.

Treasurer Rogers is working on taxes and stated the her BSA program is working much more smoothly and without lock ups.

Supervisor Isaacson stated that there is a survey regarding recycling on Iron County's website for people to fill out and submit. This will help all to realize the needs that are currently in the county regarding recycling.

Treasurer Rogers made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Trustee Stolberg. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
