

STAMBAUGH TOWNSHIP BOARD

Regular Meeting

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on March 11, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Clerk Christensen, Treasurer Rogers and Trustees Pangrazzi and Stolberg in attendance. Water Supervisor, Wyatt Johnson, was also present.

The minutes were read by Clerk Christensen from the February 11, 2026, meeting and accepted as read with corrections to the previous meeting date and a private home that had flooded on Co. Rd. 424 not the Indian Lake pumphouse.

Clerk Christensen read the bills for the month. Trustee Stolberg made a motion to approve the bills with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Motion carried.

Treasurer Rogers read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

\$1,367,575 was collected by Treasurer Rogers for the winter tax season.

Mike Staudt with the Stanley Lake Homeowners Association reported on the status of the milfoil issue in their lake. The removal of milfoil will continue in 2026 to help eradicate as much of it as possible.

Our Zoning Administrator, Rick Rogers, is retiring from his position. Cory Walsh expressed interest in being his replacement. Supervisor Isaacson made a motion to replace Rogers with Walsh with a second from Trustee Pangrazzi. Motion carried.

Supervisor Johnson reported that he had spoken to a rep at Nexgen to bore the approximate 385' under Bass Lake at an estimate of \$5,500. Kleiman Well Drilling will look at our Indian Lake well which has not been operating properly. Had a few more waterline leaks that were repaired and assisted Bates Township with a repair that required use of the new excavator. Scott Tarsi, Iron River Township Supervisor, is ordering a second bucket for the new excavator without teeth.

Supervisor Isaacson reported that the bids were in for the ditching on Forest View and Brule River Roads for \$56,654 and \$101,159 and overlay on Cataldo Drive for \$136,655. Trustee Stolberg made a motion to accept these bids with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Motion carried.

Discussion regarding the wording for the millage renewal for the Windsor Center to be placed on the ballot for the August 2026 election took place. Treasurer Rogers made a motion to approve the resolution language with a second from Trustee Stolberg. Motion carried.

Our annual meeting will take place on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall. Clerk Christensen will place a notice in the local newspaper.

Supervisor Johnson discussed waterlines in the township that need replacing because of age or ongoing issues and reported that the state inspector will be here next week.

Clerk Christensen brought up the need to raise our hall rent because of income loss with expenses that occur with a rental and damage that has taken place. Trustee Stolberg made a motion to raise the rent to residents to \$150, non-residents to \$250 and weddings at \$275. The deposit amounts will remain the same at \$100 for residents and non-residents and \$175 for weddings. A second to this motion was made by Treasurer Rogers. Motion carried. Clerk Christensen will update the contract and submit it for placement on our website.

Supervisor Isaacson read the zoning permits.

Our next regular meeting will be held on April 8, 2026.

Trustee Stolberg made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Meeting adjourned at 8:04 p.m.
