June 10, 2026

Meeting Minutes

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on June 10, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Clerk Christensen, Trustees Pangrazzi and Stolberg in attendance. Absent was Treasurer Rogers. Water Supervisor, Wyatt Johnson, was also present along with nine residents.

The minutes were read by Clerk Christensen from the May 13, 2026, meeting and accepted as read.

Clerk Christensen read the bills for the month. Trustee Stolberg made a motion to approve the bills with a second from Trustee Pangrazzi. Motion carried.

Supervisor Isaacson read Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

Zach Hautala with ICECA reported that the infrastructure was completed for the CF Housing Development project. The Fast Track Grant program is still accepting applications until June 9th. Over \$50,000 have been provided for small businesses in Iron County to date. The summer activities throughout the county will be numerous for all to enjoy.

Craig Richardson with Wickwire proposed a plan for professional engineering services for a water system capital improvement plan for \$13,000. Trustee Pangrazzi made a motion to approve this plan with a second from Trustee Stolberg.

Supervisor Johnson stated that he feels our utility rates need to be reviewed as our township is in the lower bottom of state statewide.

Further, he discussed quotes from Dixon for \$33,000 and St. Germain Sandblasting for \$13,000 for the township to be in compliance with our water tower. Trustee Pangrazzi made a motion to accept the quote from St. Germain Sandblasting with a second from Trustee Stolberg. Motion carried.

The Bass Lake project is completed and will save us thousands of gallons of water daily.

Supervisor Isaacson stated that Cataldo Drive is completed and the Brule River and Forestview Roads projects will begin next.

The Holmes Park improvement project was discussed. The project will be put out for bids.

Discussion took place regarding our website being made ADA compliant for accessibility for people with disabilities which will be required in the near future. Trustee Pangrazzi made a

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motion to have North Country Website revamp our current website to make it compliant with a second from Trustee Stolberg.

Our township clean up will take place on June 27th from 8 a.m. to noon in the parking lot at the hall.

Supervisor Isaacson read the zoning permits.

Our next regular meeting will be held on July 8, 2026.

Trustee Stolberg made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Trustee Pangrazzi. Meeting adjourned at 8:07 pm.
