Regular Meeting

May 13, 2026

Meeting Minutes

The meeting of the Stambaugh Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Isaacson on May 13, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Stambaugh Township Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call was taken with Supervisor Isaacson, Clerk Christensen, Treasurer Rogers and Trustees Pangrazzi and Stolberg in attendance. Water Supervisor, Wyatt Johnson, was also present along with thirteen residents and three children.

The minutes were read by Clerk Christensen from the April 8, 2026, meeting and accepted as read.

Clerk Christensen read the bills for the month. Treasurer Rogers made a motion to approve the bills with a second from Trustee Pangrazzi. Motion carried.

Treasurer Rogers read the Treasurer's report which was accepted as presented.

Residents, Mr. & Mrs. Coates, asked what the zoning status was in the Theodore Street area. Supervisor Isaacson stated that it was zoned residential. Mr. Coates shared concern regarding the TK Auto & Transmission business that is established on Division Street and produced pictures of the blight on the property. Zoning Administrator, Cory Walsh, will look into it.

Milfoil abatement continues on Stanley and Chicaugon Lakes. Angie Stine from the Stanley Lake Association requested funding again to help with the abatement. She will submit her request in written form. Supervisor Isaacson stated that the township had budgeted for a donation for both Stanley and Chicaugon Lake associations for this problem.

Brian Lounsbury, a resident on Golden Lake, was seeking support from the township to ban all wake enhanced boats because of the damage that they can cause. Supervisor Isaacson encouraged him to contact the DNR regarding this matter.

Supervisor Johnson reported that he has been locating waterlines for the fiber optic project that is ongoing in the township. Road signs are being replaced and restoration is being done from winter waterline repairs.

EGLE sees the need for the gaskets in the water tower to be repaired/replaced. They would also like to see an alarm system installed that would notify Supervisor Johnson if the water level dropped. Concerns regarding our underground tanks by Hagerman and Indian Lakes were voiced because of age and placement.

Summer road project contracts were signed for Cataldo Drive, Brule River Road and Forestview Drive.

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The bike path has been swept by Ryan's Excavating.

Holmes Park proposal has been reviewed and discussion will continue regarding this project.

The township clean-up will take place on June 27th from 8 am to noon in the parking lot by the hall.

Jill Walsh stated that many rental property owners do not want to comply with our Short-Term Rental agreement.

All is good at the Windsor Center and the cemetery crew have started working on the cemetery grounds.

Supervisor Isaacson read the zoning permit.

Our next regular meeting will be held on June 10, 2026.

Trustee Stolberg made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Treasurer Rogers. Meeting adjourned at 7:59 p.m.
